VINTAGE

Overall a very cool growing season with no major heatwaves, allowed for a slower ripening period than in the last few years, which helped flavour development. This allowed harvest at optimum maturity without the sugar content being too high. A weak La Nina event produced some good springs rains which assisted growing early in the season. Minimal damaging weather conditions such as frost, wind and hail with no disease pressue.

PALATE	Vibrant and intense flavours of lemon zest and kaffir lime with interwoven fine minerality and wet slate nuances. The fine linear structure gives focus and length, with balanced refreshing mouth-watering acidity giving a crisp dry finish.					
WINEMAKING NOTES	Machine harvested, destemmed and gently pressed taking only the free run juice. Fermented in stainless steel using neutral yeast isolated in Germany. Stabilised filtered and bottled young to capture the purity of Riesling.
