

CHOCOLATE BOX GRENACHE/SHIRAZ/MATARO 2017

GRAPE VARIETY:

46.46% Grenache

43.48% Shiraz 10.06 % Mataro

VINTAGE:

2017

REGION:

Barossa Valley

TYPICAL ANALYSIS:

15.0% Alc/vol, 3.55 pH, 5.6 g/L TA

OPTIMAL DRINKING:

Drinking well now and for the next 5 years.

COLOUR:

Deep red with hints of garnet and amethyst.

BOUQUET:

Subtle aromas of spicy oak, mulberry and cherries.

PALATE:

Dark cherries, chocolate and spice with silky smooth tannins.

VITICULTURE:

Low yielding fruit was sourced from selected premium Barossa

Valley Vineyards.

WINE MAKING:

The selected fruit was crushed into open fermenters for up to 10

days extended fermentation.

STORAGE/ MATURATION: 15 months in seasoned French oak barriques.

FOOD MATCHES:

A perfect match with roast lamb.
